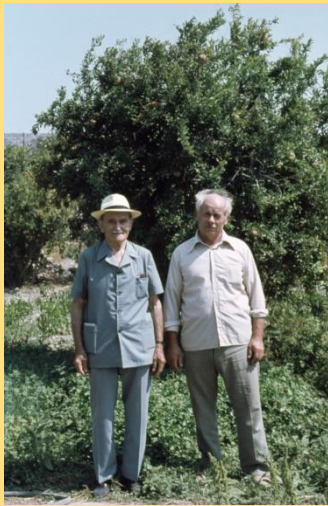

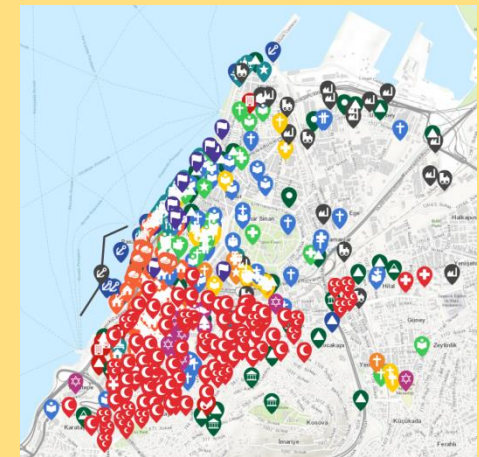

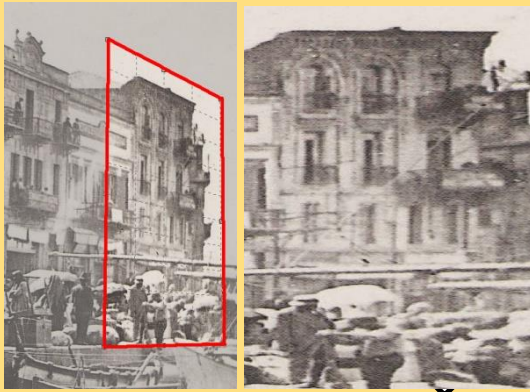

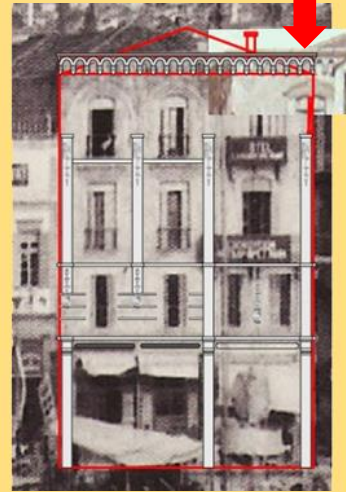

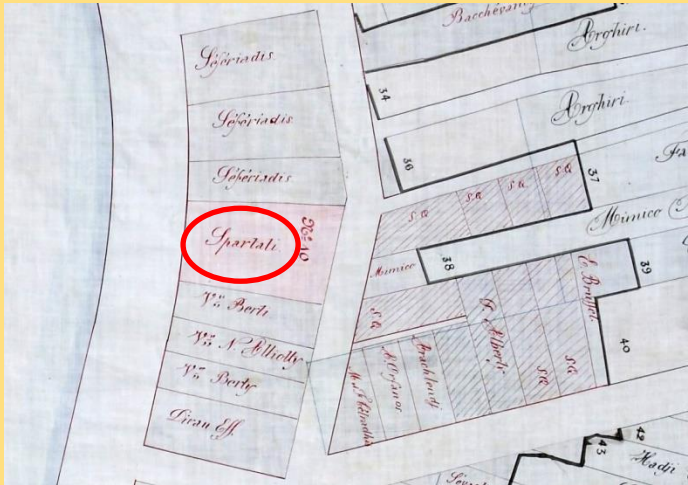

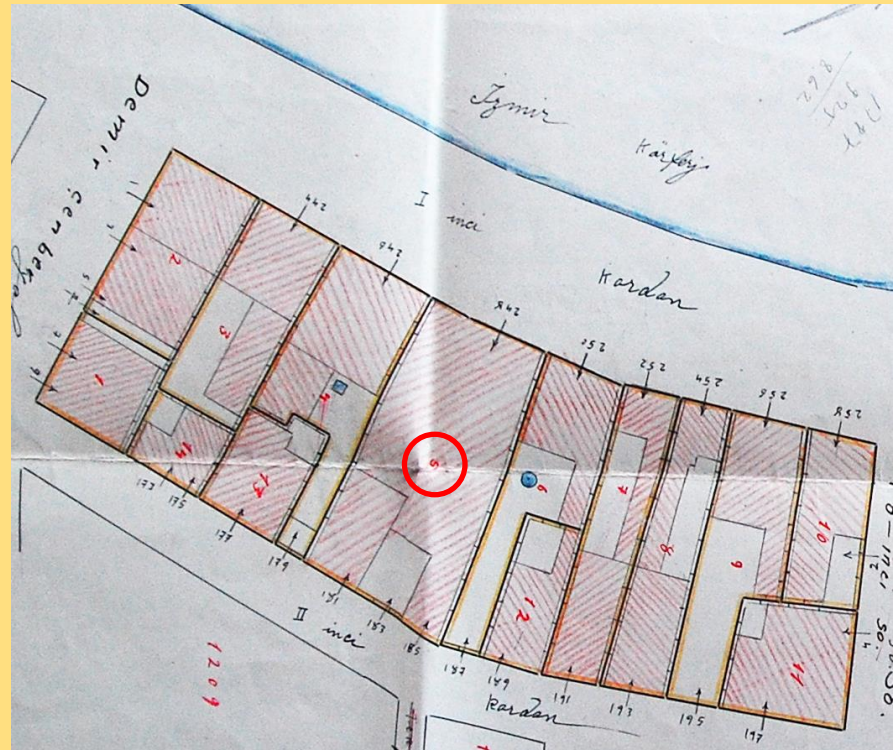

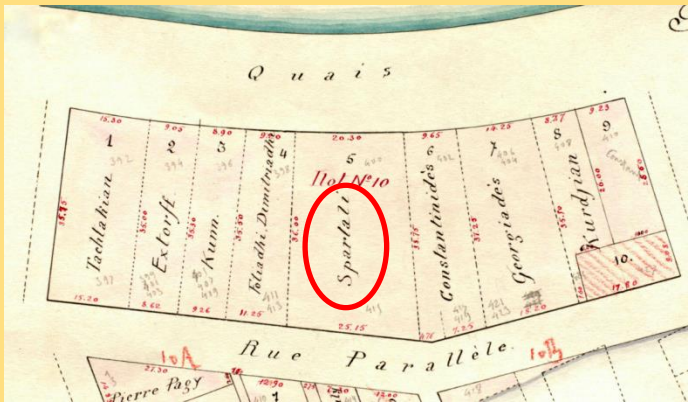

Vitalis plan, 1889



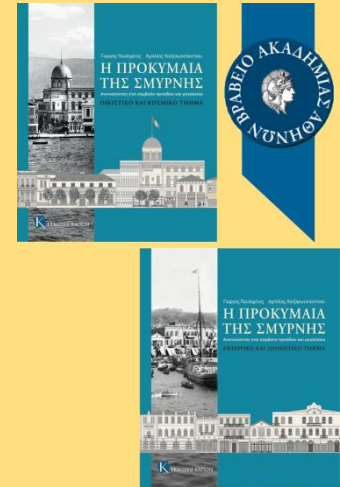
İzmir cadastral plan, 1936
